Dear Parents and Staff,

In Compliance with the US Environmental Protection Agency, (EPA), Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), we have performed school building inspections for asbestos-containing building materials and have developed an AHERA Asbestos Management Plan. The facility findings and asbestos management plan is on file in the school office, for public review.

The EPA requires us to perform surveillances of the asbestos materials every six months and to conduct re-inspections every three years. Our 3 year re-inspection was concluded in October 2018. All asbestos materials are in satisfactory condition and we shall continue to manage them in place, as recommended by the accredited management planner.

During the past year, no significant changes in the asbestos materials condition were noted during the most current surveillance of this school/facility. There are no asbestos related activities scheduled in the upcoming year. It is the intention of QCCS to comply with all Federal and State regulations to control asbestos and take whatever steps are necessary to ensure students and employees a healthy and safe environment in which to learn and work.
